Terms and Conditions

Scholarships

1. ASEAN Science and Technology Undergraduate Merit Scholarships are available for Semester 1 and 2, 2020, each covering 50% registered tuition fees, including Student Services and Amenities Fees, for the full duration of the eligible courses listed in clause 2.
2. Scholarships are available for the following eligible courses:
 - Bachelor of Agricultural Science - 73M
 - Bachelor of Applied Science (Agriculture and Business) - P3K
 - Bachelor of Applied Science (Environmental Science) - 73U
 - Bachelor of Architecture and Built Environments - P3H
 - Bachelor of Engineering (Specialisation) with Honours - P4D
 - *Civil, Electronics & Communications, Electrical & Electronics, Electrical Power, Mechanical*
 - Bachelor of Engineering (Specialisation) with Honours - P4F1
 - *Naval architecture, Ocean engineering, Marine and Offshore engineering*
 - Bachelor of Global Logistics and Maritime Management - P3E
 - Bachelor of Information and Communication Technology - P3T
 - Bachelor of Marine and Antarctic Science - P3L
 - Bachelor of Science - P3O
 - Bachelor of Surveying and Spatial Sciences - 73G
3. Scholarships are not transferable between courses and will only be offered for the above eligible courses. Programs listed in clauses 2 will be referred to as an 'eligible College of Sciences and Engineering (CoSE) degree' within these terms and conditions.
4. The scholarship will be given in the form of a fee waiver at the start of each semester, provided that the student is enrolled in a full-time 100% load (4 x 12.5% units or equivalent), in the courses noted above on the census date of that study period.

Eligibility

5. To be eligible, students must:
 - (a) be a citizen of one of the ten (10) ASEAN nations (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam) and be classified as an International Student as defined under the rules of the University of Tasmania;
 - (b) not be a student from a TNE partner affiliated with the University of Tasmania;
 - (c) have received an offer of a full-time place in an eligible College of Sciences and Engineering (CoSE) degree (refer clause 2);
 - (d) be commencing the first year of their program in Semester 1 or 2, 2020;
 - (e) have met the minimum academic requirements as determined by an assessment made by the University of Tasmania on the basis of country specific grading scales; and
 - (f) pay the commencement fee outlined in their Letter of Offer and provide evidence of payment as set out in the Letter of Offer;

- (g) applicants can be either an off-shore applicant (not currently in Australia) or an on-shore applicant (currently in Australia);
- (h) Applicants who apply for academic credit or advanced standing **are** eligible for this scholarship.

Application Process

- 6. Applicants are assessed automatically for the ASEAN Science and Technology Undergraduate Merit Scholarship, upon submission of their [International Student Application](#); there is no need to apply separately.
- 7. All decisions are made by the University of Tasmania and are final.
- 8. Applicants who are found not meeting the eligibility requirements for this scholarship, will automatically be assessed for the Tasmanian International Scholarship (TIS), which is the University of Tasmania's premier international scholarship providing a 25% reduction on the registered tuition fees for the duration of the course.
- 9. Applicants not eligible for TIS will automatically receive an ASEAN Careers in Science and Technology Award, which provides a 10% reduction on the registered tuition fees for the duration of the course.

Allocation of Scholarships

- 10. Applicants will be notified in their Letter of Offer.

Student Ambassador Role

- 11. Recipients of the ASEAN Science and Technology Undergraduate Merit Scholarship authorise the University of Tasmania to use, reproduce, and/or publish their image, their name and story in relation to the scholarship without compensation.
- 12. Applicants who accept the scholarship consent to becoming ambassadors for the University of Tasmania and the College of Sciences and Engineering for the duration of their degree at the University of Tasmania without compensation. This includes:
 - assisting with marketing initiatives by positively representing CoSE and the University of Tasmania;
 - sharing their positive university experiences with future students at University of Tasmania;
 - participating in a minimum of one recruitment activity a year, as agreed with CoSE; and
 - appearing in CoSE and University of Tasmania promotional materials if requested.

Actions Rendering the Scholarship void

- 13. The scholarship recipient may not repeat units or defer their eligible CoSE degree before commencing or prior to graduation.
- 14. This scholarship cannot be combined with any other University of Tasmania scholarship or bursary.
- 15. This scholarship is non-transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- 16. If at any stage during or following the process of assessing and awarding a scholarship, documents are found not to be genuine, the scholarship will be immediately withdrawn. The University excludes all liability to the maximum extent permitted by law.
- 17. Students must observe the University's rules of conduct and behaviour otherwise this scholarship will be revoked immediately; and
- 18. To retain this award, recipients are required to remain enrolled full-time (100% per year) in one of the above listed degrees and achieve a Credit (5.0/7.0) cumulative grade point average (CGPA) in all CoSE units at the end of each semester.
- 19. Scholarship recipients may not defer their commencement date unless, after applying within a reasonable time for their student visa, their visa is not issued in time for them to commence in the applicable semester.

Variation of Terms and Conditions

- 20. The University of Tasmania reserves the right to update or amend these Terms and Conditions including ceasing the promotion and awarding of these scholarships at any time without prior notice.
